### 3 HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Harmful: may cause lung damage if swallowed.

#### HUMAN HEALTH

This substance has no evidence of carcinogenic properties.

### 4 FIRST-AID MEASURES

#### INHALATION

Move the exposed person to fresh air at once. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues. When breathing is difficult, properly trained personnel may assist affected person by administering oxygen. Perform artificial respiration if breathing has stopped. Get medical attention immediately!

#### INGESTION

Make sure to remove any contact lenses from the eyes before rinsing. Promptly wash eyes with plenty of water while lifting the eye lids. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.

### 5 FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

#### EXTINGUISHING MEDIA

Extinguish with foam, carbon dioxide or dry powder.

#### SPECIAL FIRE FIGHTING PROCEDURES

Containers close to fire should be removed immediately or cooled with water. Avoid water in straight hose stream; will scatter and spread fire. Keep run-off water out of sewers and water sources. Dike for water control.

#### PROTECTIVE MEASURES IN FIRE

Self contained breathing apparatus and full protective clothing must be worn in case of fire.

#### PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS

## SPILL CLEAN UP METHODS

Extinguish all ignition sources. Avoid sparks, flames, heat and smoking. Ventilate. Stop leak if possible without risk. Absorb in vermiculite, dry sand or earth and place into containers. Flush with plenty of water to clean spillage area. Containers with collected spillage must be properly labelled with correct contents and hazard symbol.

## 7 HANDLING AND STORAGE

### USAGE PRECAUTIONS

Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Avoid inhalation of vapours/spray and contact with skin and eyes.

Keep in original container.
